Any Iron Worker working over 10 hours per day shall be entitled to two (2) lunch periods. 1st lunch period shall be 30 minutes, unpaid. 2nd lunch period shall be 20 minutes with pay.

Foreman

Guaranteed 8 hours/day 40hours/week, except jobs less than 5 days duration.

Foreman required when two (2) or more Iron Workers are on the job – employer appoints 1 as foreman. No restriction as to the employment of foremen. Employer may employ on one piece of work, as many foremen, as in his judgment, are necessary for the safe, expeditious and economical handling of same.

General Foreman required when 3 crews and 3 foreman are on the job.
